<b>TEACH PROJECT/POSTER PRESENTATION</b>					
Is the poster visually well-organized and "polished"?					
Does the poster have a professional appearance?					
Did the poster exhibit high quality writing?					
Did the poster follow the size and format requirements listed in the TEACH Program binder?					
<b>TEACH PROJECT OBJECTIVES/DESIGN</b>					
Were the goals/objectives for the TEACH project clearly stated?					
Was the topic or content area of the TEACH project original and/or innovative?					
Were the methods used to complete the TEACH project thoroughly and clearly described?					
Was the end result of the TEACH project described in sufficient detail?					
<b>TEACH PROJECT "WORKMANSHIP"</b>					
Did the TEACH poster show clear evidence of time invested in the project over the course of the fall and spring semesters?
